(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Carrie E. Dominick, her heirs and assigns.

A certain parcel of land situate in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, bounded and described as follows:-

Beginning at a stone on the North side of the right of way of the Southern Railway, on old Bridgeman Westerly corner, and running thence through middle of an old well near house, North 23 degrees 30 minutes West 291 feet to a point in road; thence with road North 50 degrees 45 minutes East 140 feet; South 77 degrees 35 minutes East 127 feet; thence with the road past the old Block House to where Birdgeman's Easterly line crosses road; thence South 41 degrees 00 minutes West 60 feet; thence South 3 degrees 15 minutes West 100 feet to Southern Railway right of way; thence with said right of way to the Beginning and containing 4.8 acres, more or less.

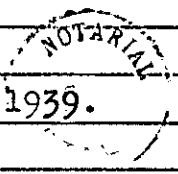
