(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
George Seaborn and Cardga Chapman all that certain piece , parcel or tract of land

situate lying and being in Dunklin Township county and State aforesaid containing one-half (1/2) of one acre and being more particularly described as follows: Beginning on line of Holly Spring Church lot, thence S65 W. 208 feet to a stake 3x on A. M. Holiday and McDuffie Chapmans line; thence S1 1/2 W. 104 feet to a stake 3x; thence N. 65 E. 200 feet to a stake 3x; thence N 1 1/2 E 104 feet to the beginning corner being bounded by lands of Holly Springs Church, A. M. Holiday and McDuffie Chapman.

This is the same plat of land conveyed by McDuffie D. Chapman to H. H. Green Worshipful Master, James Brown, Senior Warden, and Henry McKins, Junior Warden of the Holly Springs lodge No. 150 A. F.
