All that piece, parcel or lot of land fronting on the Southeast side of Furman Road, and known as Lots #5, #4, #3 and #2 plus a strip of land 10' wide adjacent to Lot No. 2 and extending back in southeasterly direction in parallel lines one hundred fifty feet to a stake thence in a southwesternly direction in parallel lines with rear of said lots 110 feet to line of property sold G.
