R. J. Vehorn.

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid and in Highland Township, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
Beginning at an iron pin the center of the Few's Bridge Road and runs thence N. 35-00 W. 1703 ft. to an iron pin and Lightwood knot; thence S. 52-08 W. 314.5 ft., to stone; thence N. 32-58 W. 287.5 ft., to stake, W. O. gone om; thence S. 59 W. 258 1/2 (261 Grady Smith _____ ft., to stone; thence from stone S. 28 W. 258 ft. to White Oak; thence S. 66 W. 1122 ft. to Sweetgum on branch 3x; thence S. 24-45 E. 187 ft. Sourwood tree 3x; thence S. 13-30 W. 116 ft. to double poplar tree on branch 3x; thence S. 41-00 E. 1030 ft. to point in center of said Few's Bridge road, corner of tracts Nos. 2 and 3 of said plat (Plat made by H. S. Brockman, surveyor, for Minnie A. Reese, (now deceased), Executrix of the Estate of I. F. Reese, Deceased, of the Old Few Place, which was the property of the said I. F. Reese); thence along the center of the said Few's Bridge road N. 55 E. 225 feet to bend in said road; thence along said road N. 66 E. 100 feet to another bend in said road; thence along said road N. 83-45 E. 108 feet to point in said road on the line of the Old Few Cemetary; then eliminating the Old Few Cemetary Plot and running on along said Few's Bridge road N. 84-15 E. 95 feet to slight bend in said road; thence along said road N. 72 E. 100 feet to point in Middle of said road, this being the corner of tracts Nos. 1 and 2; thence along said road N. 51 E. 100 feet to another slight bend in said road; thence N. 48 E. 500 feet to another bend in road; thence N. 57 E. 100 feet to another bend in said road; thence N. 68 E. 300 feet to another bend in said road; thence N. 74-45 E. 100 feet to an iron pin in the center of said road, this being the beginning corner, and containing Seventy-eight and 96/100 acres, more or less, and being all of the same tracts of land conveyed to me by D. W. and E. E. Reese by deed dated the ___ day of January 1932 less three acres deeded to J. Walter (J. W.) Rollins by me in 1934, said three acres deeded to Rollins being located on said Few's Bridge Road at the beginning corner of this tract of land and having one acre frontage on said road and being three acres deep.

The metes and bounds in this deed do not run in the same order as in said deed to B. F. Reese because in said deed there was a dividing line described between two tracts of land lying together, said dividing line being eliminated herein and because of a slight change in the line between this tract of land and an adjoining tract of land owned by R. G. Smith, said change having been agreed upon between Smith and B. F. Reese after his Surveyor, Mr. Joe Atkins, establishing the exact line for Smith.

This said tract of land herein conveyed to C. E. Sloan being bounded on the North by lands of R. G. Smith, on the East by lands of A. B. Cannon, et al; on the South by lands of George W. Few and on the West by lands of J. W. Black, et al.

This being the same tract of land conveyed to me by C. E. Sloan by deed dated the ___ day of 1937 and recorded in the Office for R. M.C. for Greenville County in Vol. 182 page 42

Instead of this tract of land containing 78 and 96/100 acres, more or less, as above specified, this tract of land contains all of the 78 and 96/100 acres, more or less, except approximately 4 1/2 acres conveyed to J. W. or Walter Rollins by me by deed dated the ___ day of
