Jesse Moseley;

All that certain piece, or parcel of land, known as Lot No. 8, Block "A", Sterling Annex Subdivision, located just beyond the City limits of Greenville, S. C. Greenville Township, Greenville County. Said subdivision adjoining the property formerly known as Sterling College. The said lot is more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of Maloy Street 350 ft. from the northeast corner of Valentine and Maloy Streets; thence with line of last mentioned street N. 48-25 E. 50 ft. to an iron pin; thence S. 42-50 E. 145.30 ft. to an iron pin; thence S. 48-05 W. 50 ft. to an iron pin; thence N. 42-50 W. 145.56 ft. to the beginning corner.
