Roy Waters, his heirs and assigns.

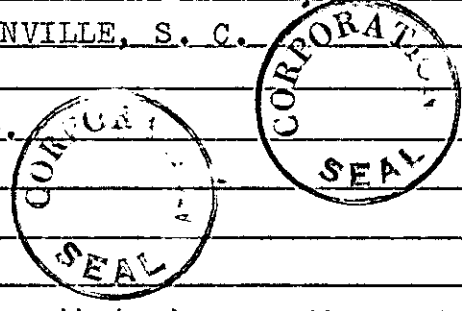
