TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS, R. N. Smith County Treasurer of said Greenville County, did issue his warrants directed to the Delinquent Tax Collector for said County and State by authority of the acts of the General Assembly of South Carolina and the statute laws of said State, against James Connor defaulting taxpayer of said County strictly charging and commanding said Delinquent Tax Collector of said County to levy by distress and sale of the lands of the said James Connor tax defaulter, the sum of Twenty seven and 38/100 dollars (\$27.38) including the penalties on said tax executions for the years 1926 through 1934 together with charges and costs thereof; and

WHEREAS, by virtue and authority of said warrants W. A. Hopkins the then delinquent tax collector of the State and County aforesaid, did on the 11th day of May, 1936, seize and take exclusive possession of the said property against which said taxes were assessed and levied, as hereinafter described, and on Sales Day of the month of June 1936 during the usual hours of sale, after due advertisement, sell the same to M. A. Richards and his heirs and assigns, the purchaser, hereinafter known as "grantee", and the highest bidder at such sale, for the sum of Twenty seven and 38/100 dollars and gave a receipt for said purchase money to him, and

WHEREAS, more than twelve months have elapsed since the date of said sale, and the defaulting taxpayers, or any other party interested, have failed to redeem said land so sold for taxes;

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT I, M. L. Ashmore Delinquent Tax Collector of and for the County and State aforesaid, in consideration of the premises, and the sum of Twenty seven and 38/100 (\$27.38) Dollars to me paid by the said grantee M. A. Richards have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, sell, bargain and release unto the said grantee, M. A. Richards, his heirs and assigns:

All that lot, piece, or parcel of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as lot #634 of plat #7 of the property of the Tryon Development Co., known as Lake Lanier, made by George Kershaw, C. E., and duly recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in plat book # \_\_\_\_\_ page # \_\_\_\_\_, said lot having a frontage of 51.5 feet, a rear width of 34.2 feet, and a depth of 150 feet on one line and 150 feet on the other line as will more fully appear from the said plat, reference being hereby made to the record thereof for a more particular description of the lot herewith conveyed.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To Have and to hold all and singular the premises hereby granted, with the appurtenances, unto the said M. A. Richards his heirs and assigns, forever, according to the form in force and effect of the laws and usages of the State of South Carolina in such cases made and provided.
