\$1.00 Received of the SOUTHERN BELL TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY,
One & 00/100 Dollars in consideration of which I hereby grant unto said Company, its associated and allied companies, their respective successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate and maintain its lines of Telephone and Telegraph, and for the general transmission of intelligence, consisting of such poles, wires, cables, conduits, guys, anchors and other fixtures and appurtenances as the grantee may from time to time require, upon, across, over and/or under the property which I own or in which I have any interest in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina and upon, along and/or under the roads, streets, or highways adjoining the said property, and the right to permit the attachment of and/or carry in conduit wires and cables of any other company or person, and with the futher right to trim and cut down and keep trimmed and cut down all trees and undergrowth within 10 feet of said line, said sum being received in full payment for the rights herein granted. The above mentioned line to be constructed along and parallel the Paris Mountain road and with the understanding that no poles are to be located over 23 feet from center of said road. The Telephone Company agrees to relocate at its own expense, on said property, its lines and fixtures to conform with future building improvements, roads, street or drives.
