AGREEMENT.

King, in consideration of the sum of \$1.00 to us in hand paid, and other valuable considerations, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hereby agree to keep open an alley ten (10) feet wide along the rear east line of our lot, as shown on the plat referred to in the above description, and have given, granted, and by these presents do give, grant and convey unto C. M. Gaffney, his heirs and assigns, right of way and easement over said alley-way, with the right of ingress and egress over said alley-way to C. M. Gaffney, his tenants, heirs and assigns.
