WHEREAS, thereafter the name of the said Church was by the Enoree Presbytery changed to the First Presbyterian Church of Greer, S. C.

WHEREAS, the said Church under the last above name has since then become incorporated under the laws of this State, and it is desired to transfer the physical property of the said Church from the membership as an unincorporated association to the corporate body, now, therefore, BE IT KNOWN, that we, the undersigned, constituting the present Board of Deacons of the said The First Presbyterian Church, of Greer, S. C. in consideration of the proposed transfer of the property of the said Church to the corporation so named, and pursuant to Resolution of the Congregation of the said Church thereunto duly entered, moved and unanimously adopted, have granted, bargained, sold, released and transferred, and by these Presents do hereby grant, bargain, sell, release and transfer to the said The First Presbyterian Church, of Greer, S. C. a corporation, its successors and assigns:

That certain lot or parcel of land, with all improvements, movable and immovable, thereon, situate in the Town of Greer, Greenville County, South Carolina, and delineated according to a plat and resurvey thereof by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, on November 5th. 1937, as follows: Beginning at a stone and stake by an English Maple on the southern edge of South Main Street, at corner of J. H. Walker lot, and running thence with the J. H. Walker line, S. 13-10 E. 102.3 feet to stake, cornering on the J. H. Walker line with the Greer Grammar School lot; thence with the School lot, N. 78-20 E. 231 feet, to a mark in the center of drive-way on the western edge of School Street; thence with the copying on the western edge of said School Street, N. 12-42 W. 211.6 feet to corner of copying at corner of School Street and Victoria Avenue; thence with the south edge of sidewalk of Victoria Avenue, S. 77-55 W. 98.5 feet to stake; thence with the southern or south-eastern edge of South Main Street, S. 38-20 W. 170 feet to the point of beginning, (all measurements exclusive of side walks), and containing 41.557 square feet.

TOGETHER WILL ALL and SINGULAR the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtanances to the said Premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining.

C. its successors and assigns, to and for the uses and purposes and under the restrictions and limitations as mentioned and set forth in the said deed of W. T. Shumate, recorded in Book LL, page 21.

And we do hereby bind ourselves, our successors in office, and assigns, to warrant and -forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said The First Presbyterian Church, of Greer, S. C., its successors and assigns, against ourselves, our successors in -office and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
