## TITLE TO REALESTATE

WHEREAS, MORE THAN TWELVE MONTHS Have elapsed since the date of said sale, and the defaulting taxpayers, or any other party interested, have failed to redeem said land so sold for taxes;

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT I, M. L. Ashmore Delinquent Tax Collector of and for the County and State aforesaid, in consideration of the premises, and the sum of Twnety one & 70/100 Dollars to me paid by the said grantees, The Forfeited Land Commission have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, sell, bargain and release unto the said grantees, The Forfeited Land Commission their heirs and assigns:
