M. Smith and others and on the South and East by other lands of the grantors, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a stake in the South edge of Viewpoint Drive, a corner of H. M. Smith's land in Earle's line; thence with the South edge of Viewpoint Drive, S. 57-23 E., 579.7 feet to an angle iron, a new corner; thence a new line, S. 5-22 W., 391 feet to an angle iron on bank of Long Branch; thence the same course 10 feet to the center of said branch; thence up the center of the branch as it meanders 926 feet, more or less, to a point in the branch, H.
