TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS, R. N. Smith, County Treasurer of said Greenville County, did issue his warrants directed to the Delinquent Tax Collector for said County and State by authority of the acts of the General Assembly of South Carolina and the statute laws of said State, against James Joyce defaulting taxpayer of said County, strictly charging and commanding said Delinquent Tax Collector of said County to levy by distress and sale of the lands of the said James Joyce tax defaulter, the sum of Twenty One & 71/100 dollars including the penalties on said tax executions for the years 1926, 1927, 1928, 1929, 1930, 1931, 1932, 1933, 1934 & 1935 together with charges and costs thereof; and

WHEREAS, by virtue and authority of said warrants W. A. Hopkins the then delinquent tax collector of the State and County aforesaid, did on the 12th day of May, 1936 seize and take exclusive possession of the said property against which said taxes were assessed and levied, as hereinafter described, and on Sales Day of the month of June during the usual hours of sale, after due advertisement, sell the same to The Forfeited Land Commission and their heirs and assigns, the purchasers, hereinafter known as "grantees", and the highest bidder at such sale, for the sum of Twenty & 09/100 dollars and gave a receipt for said purchase money to them; and

WHEREAS, more than twelve months have elapsed since the date of said sale, and the defaulting taxpayers, or any other party interested, have failed to redeem said land so sold for taxes;

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT I, M. L. Ashmore Delinquent Tax Collector of and for the County and State aforesaid, in consideration of the premises, and the sum of Twenty one & 71/100 Dollars to me paid by the said grantees, The Forfeited Land Commission have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, sell, bargain and release unto the said grantees, The Forfeited Land Commission their heirs and assigns:

All that lot, piece or parcel of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as lot number 292 of plat number 4 of property of the Tryon Development Co., known as Lake Lanier, made by George Kershaw, C. E., and duly recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in plat book number "G", page \_\_\_\_\_.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the premises hereby granted, with the appurtenances, unto the said Forfeited Land Commission their heirs and assigns, forever, according to the form in force and effect of the laws and usages of the State of South Carolina in such cases made and provided.

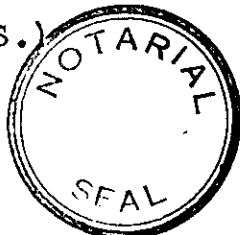
