F. L. Sentell, and his heirs and assigns forever.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, state aforesaid about four miles from the Greenville County Court House on the New Easley Bridge Road and known and designated as Lot No. 6, as shown on a plat of the property of R. J. Sentell, made by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, in June, 1934, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin in the (Right of way line) on the North side of the New Easley Bridge Road, said pine being the joint corner of Lot No. 5 and lot No. 6 and running thence N. 30-30 W. 153 feet to and iron pin which is also the joint corner of lots Nos. 5 and 6, thence S. 77-30 W. 164.4 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 12-0 E. 220 feet to an iron pin in the (Right of Way) thence N. 58-45 E. 225 feet to an iron pin the beginning corner.
