All that certain piece or parcel or tract of land lying and being in Butler Township, Greenville County, and State aforesaid, Beginning on sweet gum 3x0 W. thence N. 3 1/2 E. 10.64 to stone; thence N. 68 1/2 E. 23.65 chains to stone; thence S. 24 1/2 E. 8.27 to branch stone 3xnm; thence up the branch 29.50 to the beginning sweet gum, bounded by lands of M. G. Burns, M. B. Mahaffey, and J. B. Smith and containing twenty acres, more or less.

Also, all that parcel or tract of land lying and being in Butler Township, County and State aforesaid, adjoining lands of J. B. Smith, G. W. McDade, J. W. Boker and others, and containing four acres and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at iron pin P. O. witness; thence S. 88- 1/8 E. 7.65 to sweet gum; thence N. 2 3/4 E. 10.56 to iron pin; thence S. 38 W. 13.05 to the beginning corner.

These are the same pieces of property conveyed to me by Homer C. Hamby, as shown by deed recorded in book 180, page 463.

Also, all my undivided 1/3 interest in and to All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Laurens Road, about three and one-half miles East of the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds, according to survey made by W. J. Riddle October 18th, 1933, plat not recorded.

Beginning at a stone on the Laurens Road, Conyers and Gower's corner, and running thence with said Road N. 31.15 W. 105 feet; to an iron pin corner; thence S. 37.30 W. 752.6 feet more or less, to an iron pin corner; thence S. 50.15 E. 100 feet to corner; thence N. 37.30 E. 716.1 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner.
