Minnie Hunt Gillies, her Heirs and assigns forever all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, City of Greenville and Greenville County, State of South Carolina, as follows: Lots Nos. 27, 28, and 29, situated on the North-west side of Haviland Avenue (formerly Smith St.) Hillside Terrace, a subdivision of land according to Plat made by R. E. Dalton and recorded September 13th, 1923 in Plat Book "F" Page 154 Office of R. M. C. for Greenville County, description of which is given by metes and bounds of Lot #27 in Vol. 151, page 270 and of Lots Nos. 28 and 29 in Vol. 127, Page 170, in Office of R. M. C. for Greenville County.
