to me paid by Bishop of Charleston, a corporation sole under the laws of the State of South Carolina,

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Bishop of Charleston, a corporation sole under the laws of the State of South Carolina,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

in Ward 5 of the City of Greenville on the South side of Gower Street, and being known and designated as Lot No. 60 according to Plat recorded in Deed Book LL, page 61, R. M. C. office for Greenville County, and being more particularly described according to said Plat as follows:

Beginning at a stake on the South side of Gower Street, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 59 and 60, and running thence S. 28 1/2 W. 322 feet to a stake on joint rear corner of said lots, and also corner of Lot no. 62; thence S 74 E. 302 feet to a stake; thence S. 16 W. 101.5 feet to a stake; thence S. 74 E. 152.5 feet to a stake in line of Lot No. 61; thence with line of said lot N. 28 1/2 E. 317 feet to a stake on the South side of Gower Street; thence with said Street N. 61 1/2 W. 459 feet to the beginning corner. Said description is also in accord with Plat of H. P. Johnson, Surveyor and Engineer dated April 26, 1881, and contains 3 1/2 Acres, more or less.

The above is the same lot conveyed my mother Mrs. Rosalie E. Loveless by Thomas C. Gower and Whitner Symmes, Trustees, by deed dated December 8, 1880, and recorded in Deed Book LL, page 306 R. M. C. office for Greenville County, and was devised me by my mother in her will filed in Apt. 171, File 34, Probate Judge's office for Greenville County, and referred to in said will as the Home Place fronting on Gower Street, where the testatrix then lived, containing 3 1/2 Acres, more or less. It is also the same lot shown on page 76, Block 4, Lot 2 of the City Plat Book of the City of Greenville, S. C.
