All that piece, parcel or lot of land with improvements thereon in the Town of W. Greenville, in Greenville  
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.  
on the northern side of Iola Street and being shown and delineated as Lot No. 79 on plat of  
property of Cleveland, Williams, Mills and Symmes, known as "Donwood", made by R. E. Dalton,  
Engineer, May 20, in 1910, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book  
"A" at Page 463; bounded on the North by Lot No. 84 now or formerly owned by Julius H. Haywood;  
on the east by Lot No. 78 now or formerly owned by W. F. Foster and Annie Foster; on the South  
by Iola Street; and on the West by Lot No. 80 now or formerly owned by Julius H. Haywood; and  
having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northern side of Iola Street, corner of Lot No. 78  
and running thence with the line of said Lot, North 15-20 West, 150 feet to a stake, corner of  
Lot No. 84; thence with the line of said Lot South 74-26 West 50 feet to a stake, corner of Lot  
No. 80; thence with the line of said lot, South 15-20 East 150 feet to Iola Street; thence with  
the northern side of Iola Street North 74-26 East 50 feet to the beginning corner.
