All our right, title and interest to and in all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in Butler Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, near Gibbs Shoals, on west side of Enoree River about two miles from Pelham, S. C. Known as the estate lands of the late J. P. Green, deceased, and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on East side of Pelham Road at line of lands belonging to J. D. Holtzclaw, go N. 45 E. 8.64 to stone; thence N. 41 1/2 E. 14.98 to stone at head of small branch; thence N. 34 1/2 E. with stream 3.87; the run of the branch here turns almost due east and enters Enoree River the stream of branch is the line; thence with the bank of Enoree River to stake opposite stone in river at Green Shoal, the corner of upper line of tract No. 2 of J. P. Greene Estate lands as is shown on plat of same made by M. O. Owens November 6-7, 1934; thence S. 46 W. 6.00 to pine, new marks; thence S. 1 W. 17.45 to stake; thence S. 50 W. 4.70 to stone at corner of lands of Mrs. Mamie Smith and Miss Minnie Greene; thence S. 50 W. 8.20 to stone; thence S. 58 W. 6.38 to stone; S. 16 E. .48 to Pelham Road; thence S. 60 E. with Road 4.40; thence S. 48 E. with road 10.00 to beginning corner. Containing fifty one (51) acres. All of which is more fully shown on plat above referred to on which this tract is designated as No. 6.
