J. A. Bull, his heirs and assigns forever:

All my right title and one-half interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on both sides of Rocky Creek and on the South side of the road leading from Greenville City to Batesville and containing 390 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake 3xnm W., O. K. 340 gone, on said creek and running thence N. 48 W. 12.30 to a pin 3xom, dead; thence N. 33 W. 17.50 to a stone 3xom; thence N. 21 1/4 W. 10.44 to a stone 3xnm in Hickory stump 3x0; thence S. 54 1/2 W. along South side of Batesville road 5.36 to a stone 3xom; thence S. 7 E. 35.40 to stone 3xom; thence S. 35 1/2 W. 5.30 to sweet gum 3xom; bank of rocky creek above ford; thence S. 8 1/4 W. 13.50 to a stone 3xom; thence S. 34 E. 15.00 to a stone 3xom B. O. gone; thence N. 73 1/2 E. 3.86 to a P. O. 3xom; thence S. 11 1/2 E. 19.60 to a stone 3xom; thence S. 86 E. 12.75 to a stone 3xnm at the end of hedge row; thence S. 64 1/2 E. 15.55 to a stone 3xnm; thence N. 29 E. 21.75 to a stone 3xnm; thence N. 65 3/4 E. 20.00 to a stone 3xnm; thence N. 13 1/2 E. 12.32 to a stone 3xnm on side of road; thence along said road as a line 8.20 to a stone 3xnm across side creek at ford; thence up the creek with its various meanderings to the beginning, adjoining lands formerly belonging to W. A. Hudson, John Hudson, George Bramblett, William Greer, and tract No. 1 and No. 3, the same being tract No. 5 of the division of land belonging to Henry T. Stroud and representing more particularly by plat thereof made by J. N. Southern, V. S. on the 1st day of August, 1895. See judgment roll No. 9545.
