All our right, title and interest to and in all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in Butler Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on the Gibbs Shoal Road about five miles from Greer, S. C. known as the estate lands of the late J. P. Green deceased and having the following lines and distances to wit:

Beginning at a stake on East edge of Gibbs Shoal Road at line of J. E. Holtzclaw and go S. 20.00 E. 8.00 chs. to bend in road; thence S. 17 E. 2.13 on old road to head of gully; thence N. 69½ E. with Gully 2.42 to turn in gully; thence S. 49 E. with Gully 2.00 to stake; thence N. 77 E. 7.36 to White Oak above White Oak Spring; thence S. 24 E. 1.15 to center of White Oak Spring; thence S. 72 E. 4.00 to poplar on edge of Spring branch; thence S. 68 E. 6.70 to stake on line of Estate Lands of Vaughn; thence N. 4 E. 8.15 to stake .30 links across Vaughn Branch; thence N. 78 W. 7.40 to stone; thence N. 7 W. 9:70 to stake just across small stream; thence N. 81 W. 8.10 to stone; thence S. 49½ W. 13;30 to beginning corner; containing thirty three and fifteen hundredths (33.15) acres. This is the Home tract and shown more fully on a plat of the whole estate made by M. O. Owens, Nov. 6-7, 1934 designated as tract No. 1.
