(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Don B. Green, his heirs and assigns, forever;

All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid on branch waters of Brushy Creek of Enoree River, containing twenty-three (23) acres, more or less, and having the following lines, metes and bounds:

Beginning on a stone on the old Staptanburg Road and running thence S. 5 E. 25.60 to a pine; thence S. 75 E. 8.50 to a stake; thence N. 5 W. 30.60 to a stone on the Old Spartanburg Road near and with branch; thence along old road S. 60 W. 2.00 to a stone; thence along said road S. 76 W. 6.38 the beginning, bounded by lands now or formerly belonging to E. P. Hudson, Annice and J. J. McCarter, John and Eady Sullivan and Jane E. Green being the same tract of land which was conveyed to me by J. W. Webster by deed of conveyance of date day of Oct. 1905.

Also all that other certain piece, parcel and lot of land situated in the State and County aforesaid in Butler Township on the Old Spartanburg Road about 3 1/2 miles from the City of Greenville, S. C., being a part of the Abraham Green estate and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on E P. Hudson corner and thence N. 2 E. 9.63 chains to iron pin in gully; thence down the gully N. 32 E. 2.08 to iron pin on McSwains line; thence S. 34 E. 10.38 to iron pin; thence S. 60-30 W. 1.61 to iron pin; thence S. 75-20 W. 6.27 to the beginning corner, containing 4.6 acres, more or less, and adjoining lands of T. E. Green, P. H. Harbin and J. J. McSwain.
