beginning on Buncombe Street.

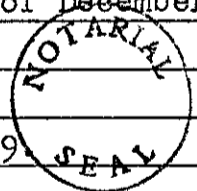
This being a portion of the property conveyed to Mary L. Bellotte, now deceased, by
