HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said _____

H. P. Jordan, Russell Jordan, Ruth Dill, Rosie Owens, Ollie Davenport, Sadie Fowler, Emma Nix, Golia Jordan, Ebbie Jordan and Alvin Jordan, their heirs and assigns:

The undivided interest of Cary Sue Jordan in and to all those certain tracts of land formerly belonging to the estate of I. P. Jordan, deceased, and having been divided amongst his heirs at law. For full information as to the division, see various deeds recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County and also a plat showing the tracts and owners, recorded in said office in Plat Book H, page 273.

The object of this deed, as will appear by the Judgment Roll, is that the interest of Cary Sue Jordan in the respective tracts of land is conveyed to the owners of the respective tracts. It is not intended that the grantees herein shall take the interest of Cary Sue Jordan in any of the tracts of land except in those tracts allotted to the grantees, respectively, in the division of the estate of I. P. Jordan, deceased.
