Charlie Littlefield and his heirs and assigns:

All of that certain parcel or lot of land situate and being in the Town of Greer, Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, bounded by Charlie Littlefield, M. K. Walker and others, and having the following courses and distances according to a plat prepared by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, dated October, 1922, to-wit:

Beginning at a n iron pin on an alley and runs thence N. 79.14 E. 51.88 feet; thence S. 10.00 E. 19 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 80.25 W. 16 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 10.00 E. 4 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 80.25 W. 35 feet and 10 1/2 inches to an iron pin on alley; thence with said alley N. 9.55 W. 21 feet and 10 inches to the beginning corner.
