Beginning at a stake at corner of lot No. 1 and running thence N. 57-20 E. 750 feet to a stake, thence N. 35-15 W. 529 feet to a stake, thence S. 55-40 W. 750 feet to a stake, thence S. 35-15 E. 509 feet to a stake the beginning corner and containing 8.80 acres, more or less.
