all that parce, tract or lot of land, lying on Ward -Hudson Road on east side of same, being in Butler Township, County and State aforesaid, adjoining lands of Willie Hudson on the west, Mrs. Gertrude Waldrop on the south, and other lands of the grantor, on the east and north, and having the following metes and bounds:-
