All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about one and one-half miles East of the City of Greenville and South of the Laurens Road and being known and designated as Lot No. 19 of the sub-division of lands of Mrs. Corinne Bates, as shown by plat made by W. J. Riddle, May 1937, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book I, page 126, and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the South side of Rhodes Street, joint corners with Lot #20 and running thence N. 61-37 E. 60 ft. to an iron pin; thence S. 28-23 E. 212 feet to a pin; thence S. 61-37 W. 60 ft. to an iron pin; thence N. 28-23 W. 212 ft. to the beginning point.
