All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County and in the State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as tract No. 3, according to plat of property of S. C. Pinson, made by Dalton and Neves, September, 1938, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
