

EXCHANGE PLANT PERMIT

Received of the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, One dollar in consideration of which I hereby grant unto said Company, its associated and allied companies, their respective successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate and maintain its lines of telephone and telegraph, and for the general transmission of intelligence, including the necessary underground and aerial cable, conduit, poles, wires and fixtures with the further right to permit the attachment of the wires of any other company, or person, to said poles and fixtures upon and over or under the property which I own, or in which I have an interest, located in the block bounded by Hillcrest Drive, Fairview Ave., N. Main and Water Sts., Line to be constructed along the (East)side property line of lot from Hillcrest Drive to rear of said lot, thence along alley back of lot near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, said sum is received in full payment of said rights.

The Company agrees to re-locate at its own expense, on said property, its lines and fixtures to conform with future building improvements.
