To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

Whereas, R. N. Smith County Treasurer of said Greenville County, did issue his warrants directed to the Delinquent Tax Collector for said County and State by authority of the acts of the General Assembly of South Carolina and the statute laws of said State, against Lillie Scott defaulting taxpayer of said County, strictly charging and commanding said Delinquent Tax Collector of said County to levy by distress and sale of the lands of the said Lillie Scott tax defaulter, the sum of Thirty eight & 09/100 Dollars including the penalties on said tax executions for the years 1926 through 1934 together with charges and costs thereof; and

Whereas, by virtue and authority of said warrants W. A. Hopkins the then delinquent-tax collector of the State and County aforesaid, did on the 12th day of May, 1936 seize and take exclusive possession of the said property against which said taxes were assessed and levied, as hereinafter described, and on Sales Day of the month of June during the usual hours of sale, after due advertisement, sell the same to R. C. Blackwell and J. A. Southern and their heirs and assigns, the purchasers, hereinafter known as "grantees", and the highest bidder at such sale, for the sum of Thirty eight & 09/100 dollars and gave a receipt for said purchase money to them, and

Whereas, more than twelve months have elapsed since the date of said sale, and the defaulting taxpayers, or any other party interested, have failed to redeem said land so sold for taxes;

Now, therefore, know all men by these presents that I, M. L. Ashmore Delinquent Tax Collector of and for the County and State aforesaid, in consideration of the premises, and the sum of Thirty eight & 09/100 Dollars to me paid by the said grantees, R. C. Blackwell and J. A. Southern have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, sell, bargain and release unto the said grantees, R. C. Blackwell and J. A. Southern their heirs and assigns:

All that lot, piece or parcel of land in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as lot number 1434 and 1435 of plat number 9 of the property of the Tryon Development Co., known as Lake Lanier, and duly recorded in the office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Plat Book "G", page 53 and described as follows:
