Agreement

Whereas, James Albert Waldrop, this day deceased, and Thomas Carroll Waldrop were devised certain real estate in the Town of Greer, and there being some question regarding the interpretation of said will, and it being necessary to obtain burial equipment for the body of the said James Albert Waldrop and to secure the Wood Mortuary in payment of the same, this agreement is executed for that purpose.

In the event the property on Arlington Avenue, in the Town of Greer, County and State aforesaid, purported to be the property of the said James Albert Waldrop, should be held unto the will of R. M. Waldrop to belong to Thomas Carroll Waldrop, the said Thomas Carroll Waldrop hereby contracts and agrees to pay to the Wood Mortuary, Inc., the sum of \$408.15 in payment of the burial and funeral expenses from the proceeds to be obtained from a sale of said lot of land, or from any other property belonging or to belong to the said Thomas Carroll Waldrop under the will of R. M. Waldrop.
