(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Ed Byrd, his heirs and assigns, forever

All that certain tract of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds;

Beginning at the joint corner of Hortense Walker and Cosgrove land, and thence running with Cosgrove Line, S. 23-10 W. 179.8 feet to a pipe; thence with Heyward's line S. 63-10 W. 368.3 feet to a stake on grantor's line; thence with the Greenville Airport Commission line N. 3-10 W. 638.7 feet to a stake on said line; thence S. 54-50 E. with Hortense Walker's line, 534.3 feet to the beginning corner, containing 3.48 acres, more or less.

The grantor was duly constituted a body politic under the Act of the Legislature of South Carolina March 10, 1928, The land here in conveyed was found by the Commission to be not suitable for airport purposes and the Commission is exchanging this land with the grantee for land that is suitable for airport purposes, said exchange having been made for the best interest of the Greenville Airport, and to carry out the purposes of said Commission in maintaining the airport. The officers of said Greenville Airport Commission signing this deed have signed the same under the full approbation and authority from the entire body constituting the Greenville Airport Commission.

The consideration expressed is the value of the land the grantee conveys to the grantor, this being an exchange of land of equal value.
