in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release, unto the said G. Thurmon Ownes, his heirs and assigns

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the City of Greenville, and being designated as Lot No. 6, Block A of a Sub-division known as Sunny Slope, surveyed by R. E. Dalton in May 1919, said plat being recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book F, at page 86, and being more particularly described by reference to said plat as follows: BEGINNING at the Southeastern intersection of Fortner Street and Zarline Street and running thence with Zarline Street S. 9-48 W. 150 feet to a point, joint corner of lots Nos. 6 and 7, Block A; thence S. 80-05 E. 50 feet to a point, joint Southern corner of lots Nos. 5 and 6; thence along the line of lot No. 5 N. 9-48 E. 150 feet to a point on the South side of Fortner Street, joint Northern corner of lots Nos. 5 and 6; thence along the South side of Fortner Street N. 80-05 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
