of R. M. C. office for Greenville County in plat Book E, at page 217, said lots being on Main
Street and having a frontage of 25 feet each, see R. M. C. Office record in Vol. 71 at page 405.

Also all that other piece, parcel or lot of land adjoining the above described lots a
and being known as lot No. 80 and a part of lot No. 79 of the above named subdivision as per plat
on file in R. M. C. Office in Plat Book A, at page 133 and having the following courses and
distances.

Beginning at a stake at the Northwest intersection of Main and Linton Streets and
running thence along said Main St. N. 62 1/2 E. 113 feet to a stake, thence N. 27 1/2 W. 11 1/4 feet
