All that parcel, tract or lot of land, lying on North side of Highway No. 253 about one-fourth of a mile east of Little Texas School House, and being crossed by a county public road leaving above named Highway and running in a northerly direction, being in O'Neal Township and in County and State aforesaid, and adjoining subdivisions of T. R. Robertson Estate Nos. 1, 2, 4 and having the following metes and bounds:-

Beginning at an iron pin at the T. R. Robertson spring, thence S. 23-3/4 W. 4.28 chains to a point in center of branch; thence S. 44 1/4 W. 2.41 chains to an iron pin on south bank of Highway No. 253 and on west bank of branch, thence along Highway No. 253 N. 43 1/4 W. 5.69 chains to a point in center of the highway at the place where a county public road leaves said highway in a northerly direction, thence continuing along Highway No. 253 N. 63 1/4 W. 2.35 chains to a point on south of said highway, thence N. 29 1/4 E. 7.36 chains to iron pin in road on south side of small bridge, thence N. 81 E. 2.24 chains to iron pin on a gully, thence along said gully S. 73 1/4 E. 4.25 chains to a possimmon tree, thence S. 34 1/4 E. 2.98 chains to a Birch east of a branch, thence S. 19-3/4 W. 2.53 chains to an iron pin on the branch, thence S. 44 E. 1.16 chains to the beginning corner and containing 8.75 acres, more or less, according to a survey made by J. Earle Freeman Mar. 14, 1939.
