lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being known as Lot No. 5 in a Sub-Division known as Eastover, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin 288.3 feet from an iron pin at the corner of Ackley and Maco Streets and running thence S. 53.49 W. 118.92 feet to a stake joint corner of Lots No. 6 and 5; thence N. 30 W. 22.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 37-01 W. 33.30 feet to a stake, joint corner of Lot No. 5 and a lot conveyed by Wm. Timmons to Wilmot Smith; thence N. 53-50 E. 116.95 feet to an iron pin on Maco Street; thence with Maco Street S. 36-16 W. 56 feet to the beginning corner.
