All that certain tract or lot of land lying and being situate in State and County aforesaid,
about two miles south west of the City of Greenville in the vicinity of "Fallis" it being all of
lot No. 1 as shown by a plat made by G. A. Ellis, Surveyor Feb. 21st, 1940, and having the
following meets and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at the junction of Bradley Street and White Circle, thence with
White Circle N. 43-15 E. 110 feet to iron pin on White Circle, joint corner of lots No. 1 and 2
thence N. 20-30 W. 100 feet to iron pin on line of lot N 2 and 8, thence with line of lot No. 8,
S. 63-30 W. 105 feet to iron pin on Bradley Street, thence with Bradley Street S. 24 E. 135 feet
to the beginning corner.

Also all that other certain tract or lot of land lying and being situate in State and
County aforesaid, about two miles South west of the City of Greenville, in the vicinity of "Fallis"
it being all of lot No. 6 as shown by a plat made by G. A. Ellis Surveyor Feb. 21st, 1940, and
having the following meets and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Bradley Street joint
corner of Clayborn and Lot No. 6, thence with Clayborn's line N. 64-30 E. 185 feet to iron pin,
joint corner of Lot No. 5 thence S. 16 E. 65 feet to iron pin on line of lot No. 5, thence S.
64-30 W. 185 feet to iron pin on Bradley Street joint corner of lots No. 6 and 7; thence with
Bradley Street N. 24 W. 65 feet to the beginning corner.
