All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina and in the Town of Greer, known and designated as lot No. 20 on a plat known as Westmoreland Circle property made by J. W. Riddle Surveyor, December 1921, Bounded by lots Nos. 17, 18 and 21, fronting on Lanford Street 50 ft. and fronting also on Green Street 50.1 being 158.5 feet deep on one line and 162.4 feet on the other.
