Beginning at a point on the West side of Leach Street, 280 feet from the North West corner of Leach Street and Perry Avenue, and running thence with the West side of Leach Street, N. 18-1/2 E. 80 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 71 1/2 W. 200 feet to an iron pin in T. O. Lawton, Jr's line; thence S. 18 1/2 W. with the said T. O.
