All that certain, piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Oneal Township, near Sandy Flat, and lying in between the Sandy Flat Road and the Double Springs Road, and being bounded on the East by lands of W. S. Dill, on the North by lands formerly owned by N. A. Collins, on the West by the Sandy Flat Road and on the South East by Theron Collins, and being the same land conveyed to me by deed from E. Inman, Master of Greenville County, July 10th, 1923 and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. in and for Greenville County in Deed Book 94 at page 196, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:-

Beginning on a point in the Sand Flat Road (iron pin on the East bank of the road) and being the corner of the lands formerly belonging to N. A. Collins, and runs thence with the said road S. 68-45 W. 105 feet to a point in the said road; thence S. 12-30 W. 700 feet to a stone on the West bank of a small branch, Theron Collins corner; thence S. 16-20 E. 1339 feet to an iron pin, W. S. Dill's corner; thence N. 74-42 E. 1551.5 feet to an iron pin and stone on the East side of the Double Springs Road; thence with this road N. 1145 E. 198 feet to a point in the said road and on the line of land formerly belonging to N. A. Collins; thence with the said line N. 50-20 W. 2178 feet to the beginning corner and containing Forty Seven (47.00) acres, more or less.
