KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, H. E. Stewart & Mrs. Frances S. Shepard in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar to us in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and for other valuable considerations, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the County of Greenville, its successors, and assigns, a right-of-way, as hereinafter described, on and over all lands which we may own in whole or in part.

IT IS THE INTENTION OF THE DEED to convey such parts, parcels or strips of our land that may be needed to convey a right-of-way having the width of Forty (40') feet, that is, Twenty (20') Feet on each side of the center line, as staked out by the Engineer, except where there should be a cut or fill, may be necessary for extra width.

This right-of-way beginning at property line of F. H. Hill and extending to that of J.E. Snyder.
