Beginning at a stone near Bridge Road, corner Morgans Land and running thence S. 70 W. 4.88 to a stone; thence S. 60 W. 4 to a stone; thence S. 81-30 W. 1.95 to a stone corner of Morgans land; thence S. 14 W. 14.75 to a Spanish Oak; thence N. 87 W. 14.30 to a Chestnut; thence S. 8 E. 18.60 to a stake; thence S. 83 W. 6.50 to a stone corner of H. B. Bruells land; thence S. 9-30 W. 6.50 to a Sweet Gum on branch; thence S. 55 E. 3550 to an angle on branch; thence S. 86-30 E. 3.43 to an angle on branch; thence S. 67-45 E. 2.14 to a stake in branch; thence S. 8 E. 15.90 to a stake on top of hill corner of land formerly owned by J. J.
