Moon, Surveyor, October, 1940, said plat recorded in office of R M C for said County and State, said lots fronting on the north side of the Super Highway about two and a half miles west of the town of Greer, and each measuring 50 feet front and rear, lot No. 9 being 225 feet in depth and the other six measuring 200 feet in depth, all running back in parallel lines.
