All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Northeast side of Claremore Avenue, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot 29 in Block I, Section No. 5 on Plat of East Highlands Estates made by Dalton & Neves, February, 1941, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book K, at pages 79 and 80, and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Claremore Avenue, joint front corner of Lots 28 and 29 of Block I, and running thence with the line of Lot 28 N. 56-33 E. 163.8 feet to an iron pin on the Southwest side of a five foot strip reserved for utilities; thence with the Southwest side of said strip N. 31-01 W. 90 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots 29 and 30; thence with the line of lot 30 S. 50-00 W. 174 feet to an iron pin on the Northeast side of Claremore Avenue; thence with said Claremore Avenue S. 37-36 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner.

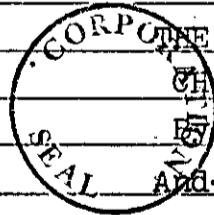
