RENUNCIATION OF DOWER.

Speegle, did this day appear before me, and, upon being privately and separately examined by me, did declare that she does freely, voluntarily and without any compulsion, dread or fear of any person or persons whomsoever, renounce, release and forever relinquish, unto the within named C. D. Speegle, his heirs and assigns, all her interest and estate, and also all her right and claim of dower, of, in or to any land or lands of the said C. D. Speegle or deeds heretofore made or hereafter to be made by him. Said dower accrued or hereinafter to accrue to her by reason of her marriage to the said C. D. Speegle, including all claims of dower inchoate or hereafter accruing in any land or lands now or hereafter owned by the said C. D. Speegle, and she does hereby covenant with the said C. D. Speegle and bind herself not to claim dower by reason of said marriage in any land or lands presently owned or acquired or hereafter owned or acquired by him, the consideration of this renunciation of dower being the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000), receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged this 21 day of December, 1940.
