HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

S. T. Bright and J. O. Bright

"All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in
the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Gantt Township, containing one
acre, more or less, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning in the center of White Horse Road on W. K. Myer's land at an iron
pin, and running thence S. 70 W. 6.30 to an iron pin; thence S. $4\frac{1}{2}$ W. 1.70 to an iron pin;
thence N. 70 E. 6.96 to an iron pin in center of White Horse Road; thence along said road
to the point of beginning, the foregoing description being according to a plat by W. A.
Hester, June 5, 1936."
