Tennie Campbell

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situated, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, in section about 1 1/2 miles from City limits of Greenville in section known as Fallis and being designated as No. 2 of Section 1 of Fallis Amex as shown by plat of record in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book "C" at page 101 and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at a pin on the White Horse road, 63 feet from corner of Earle Drive and running S. 32-15 W. 200 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot #27, thence S. 24 E. 63 feet to a pin joint lot corner with lot #26, thence with line of lot #3 N. 64-30 E. 200 feet to a pin on White Horse Road, thence with said Road N. 24 W. 63 feet to the beginning point.

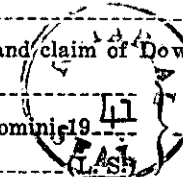
