And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Dorothye Barnes Davenport, the life tenant, and the children begotten of the marriage of Luther M. Davenport and Dorothye Barnes Davenport as shall survive the said Dorothye Barnes Davenport and all others who shall take hereunder, and their heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
