This matter comes before me on the verified petition of Bank of Ware Shoals, as Receiver of The Bank of Honea Path. By said petition said Receiver seeks to be allowed to account to the Court for its acts as such Receiver, and upon the examination of said account to be discharged from said receivership, and thereupon to have The Commercial Bank, a banking corporation at Honea Path, S. C., appointed Receiver of The Bank of Honea Path in lieu of said Bank of Ware Shoals. Petitioner likewise asks that the Court pass upon and fix the expenses of the receivership to this date, including a reasonable compensation for the attorneys for the Receiver.

Upon the presentation to the Court on June 30, 1934, of said petition, an order was made bearing said date in compliance with Section 7855 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1932, Volume III, whereby a hearing on the matters referred to therein was fixed to be held on July 13, 1934, at ten o'clock, A.
